

## Dear parents

We hope that you and your families have had a restful and safe summer holiday. We are really looking forward to welcoming all our children back to school on Monday 6<sup>th</sup> September to begin the new school year.

If your child is unwell, please get a PCR test before bringing them to school.

#### THE SCHOOL DAY

- School gates will be open at 8:45am and close at 9:00am for the start of the school day.
- One way systems when dropping off and collecting children.
- School gates will be open at 3:15pm for all families to enter and collect their children. Gates will close at 3:25pm.

#### **COVID PLANS**

Following a Headteacher meeting with Public Health yesterday, this is the new guidance for COVID-19 in primary schools:

- Pupils showing 1 or more of the 3 main classic COVID-19 symptoms must not attend school and isolate and book a PCR test (at a test centre) by calling 119 or booking online through NHS online booking.
- Pupils who develop 1 or more of the 3 main COVID-19 symptoms must be collected immediately from Scallywags and you must organise a PCR test (at a test centre).
- Pupils can only return to school when the negative test results have been seen.

#### Additional new guidance

- Some people who test positive for COVID do not always have 1 of the 3 main classic COVID-19 symptoms. Walsall Public Health have identified that people are showing other symptoms for COVID-19.
- Although these symptoms are not classic symptoms, Public Health are strongly advising people to book a PCR test (at a test centre). This is to help protect our community.
- You can register for a PCR test at a local testing centre online at www.nhs.uk/coronavirus and tick the box that says your local authority asked you to take a test. Or you can call 119 and say the same thing to book a test. You can also choose to have PCR test delivered to your home.

## Measures in school to protect our community

- One-way system
- Ensure good hygiene for everyone handwashing routines
- Maintain appropriate cleaning regimes these will continue
- Keep occupied spaces well ventilated open windows
- Follow public health advice on testing, self-isolation and managing confirmed cases of COVID-19.
