

### **Individual & Home Reading**

Our reading approach focuses on matching texts to pupils' phonic knowledge. This embeds confidence and a joy of reading. The home reading books are organised by the sounds they contain. We prioritise the pupils who need the most support in reading.

#### Aim: Ensuring all pupils can read fluently, confidently and choose to read for pleasure

Pinfold Street Primary School prioritise reading and ensure that all pupils receive the required amount of support to ensure that they can read. Class teachers and other adults will hear pupils read on an individual basis.
